

PLI publishes in three book formats: treatises, answer books, and course handbooks. Bibliographic information is available for all content, and PLI gives you the details you need to complete a citation. PLI also provides PDF chapters of each book that match the print version, including the front matter.

The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation is the most widely used legal citation manual for citing in legal memoranda, court documents, and law journals. Book citations using *Bluebook* format typically include the author's full name, the title of the book, the section or page cited, the editor's name (if applicable), the edition (if applicable), the year of publication and, in some cases, the publisher.

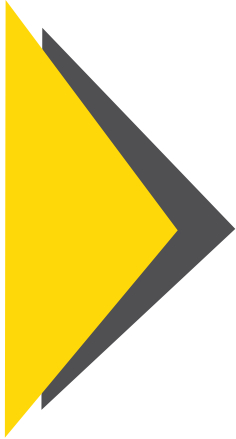
