Some highlights of Release #4:

- Deal Protection Devices in U.S. Acquisitions: Although courts have historically interpreted MAC clauses narrowly, in October 2018, the Delaware Court of Chancery, in *Akorn, Inc. v. Fresenius Kabi AG*, for the first time allowed a buyer to terminate an acquisition agreement on the basis of a "material adverse effect." (*See* § 1:5.2[F].)
- **DOL Fiduciary Rule:** The DOL Fiduciary Rule was **vacated in full by the Fifth Circuit** in 2018. States have proposed their own versions of the rule and the SEC has proposed the similar **"Regulation Best Interest."** Acquirors should be aware of this regulatory uncertainty. (*See* § 2:4.4[K] and § 9:3.7.)
- Tax Cuts and Jobs Act: The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act made significant changes to the U.S. tax system that will impact decisions on entity classification and the form of M&A transactions involving investment advisers. (See § 9:4.1.)
