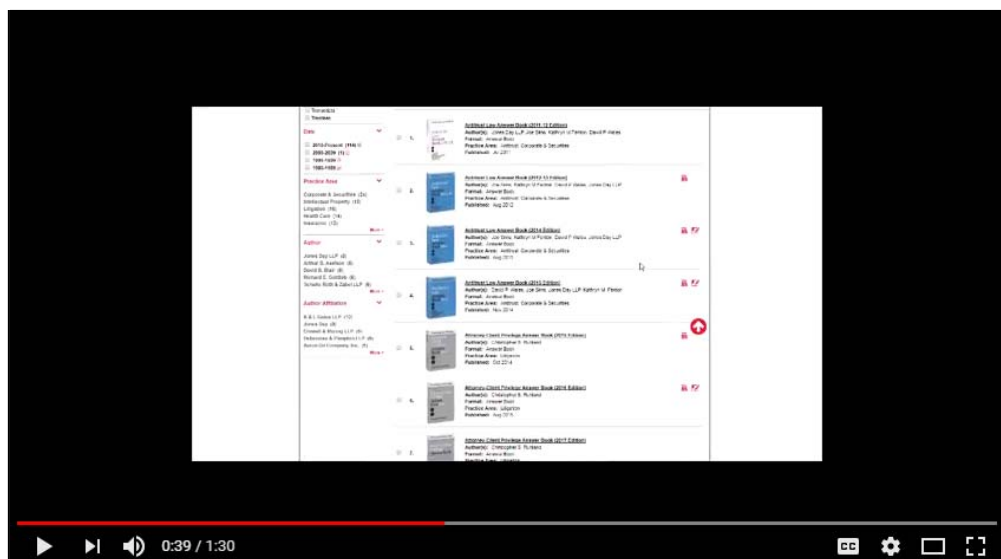
PLI PLUS continues to grow. Did you know that new content is added every week? In 2017, we added:
